We provide the support neurodiverse adults need to live a full and happy life.



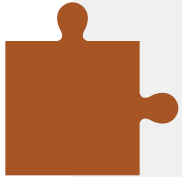
Passion

While we are autism focused, we provide services to neurodiverse adults with a variety of diagnoses. Based on the level of support each client requires, we customize our offerings to meet those needs.



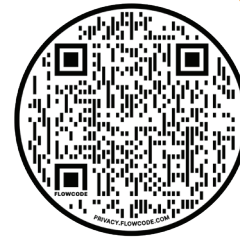
Place

Our Services at a Glance



Transition Academy

A two-year, all-inclusive educational and residential program for high-functioning young adults 18 and up with autism who need a longer runway to get ready for independent living.



Living Community

Adults 18 and up can find a short-term or forever home at this fun and safe community designed to support and celebrate neurodiversity.



Enrichment Services

A comprehensive and customized system of supports available to residents of our living community and also to those who do not live with us.



Summer Transition Experience

Participants 16 and up can enjoy the great outdoors and develop friendships while gaining social, career and life skills.



Employment Services

Our vocational specialist and trained job coaches work with clients to establish goals, develop skills and find meaningful work experiences.
