

Dr. Hines went on to pursue his medical degree from the University of Texas Health Science Center. Following graduation, Dr. Hines completed his Orthopedic Surgery Residency at Tripler Army Medical Center in Hawaii. As part of his military service, he then went into practice for several years at Irwin Army Community Hospital, Fort Riley, Kansas. After completing his Army Service obligation, he went on to complete his Sports Medicine and Shoulder Reconstruction Fellowship at the Steadman Hawkins Clinic of the Carolinas. During his fellowship, Dr. Hines provided team coverage assistance for the Colorado Rockies Spring Training and the Greenville Drive, an affiliate for the Boston Red Sox.

Dr. Hines had the honor to use his skills as a high-producing surgeon to serve the men and women in the armed forces. During his four years of military service, Dr. Hines was appointed to early leadership roles, including Chief of the Orthopedics and Podiatry Department, Deputy Chief of Surgery, and Physician Assistant Student Orthopedic Preceptor. 
